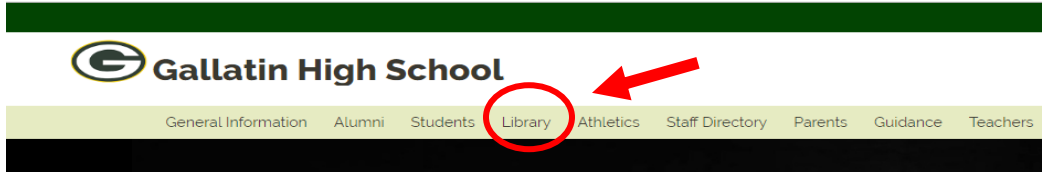


GHS Library Research and Ebook Opportunities

1. You can have direct access to all the mentioned databases by going to the **GHS Library webpage**, found by going to the GHS Homepage:

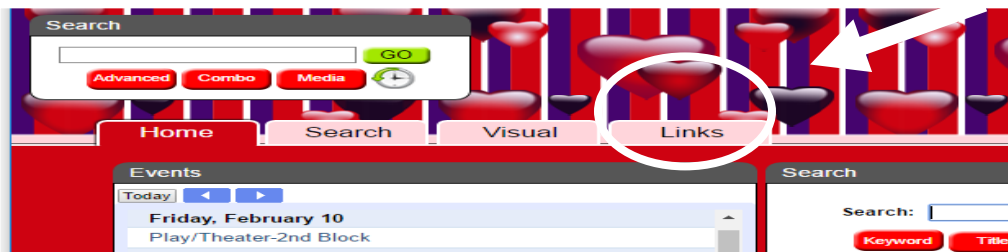


2. Now that you are on the Library's Homepage you can see all our quick links to the databases: Atrium, Follett/Destiny, Salem Press, R.E.A.D.S. and TEL (Tennessee Electronic Library). Note: when clicking on Follett/Destiny for non-fiction ebooks, just type in a search term. Once it takes you to your search results, just log in to see the dashboard and do an advanced search.



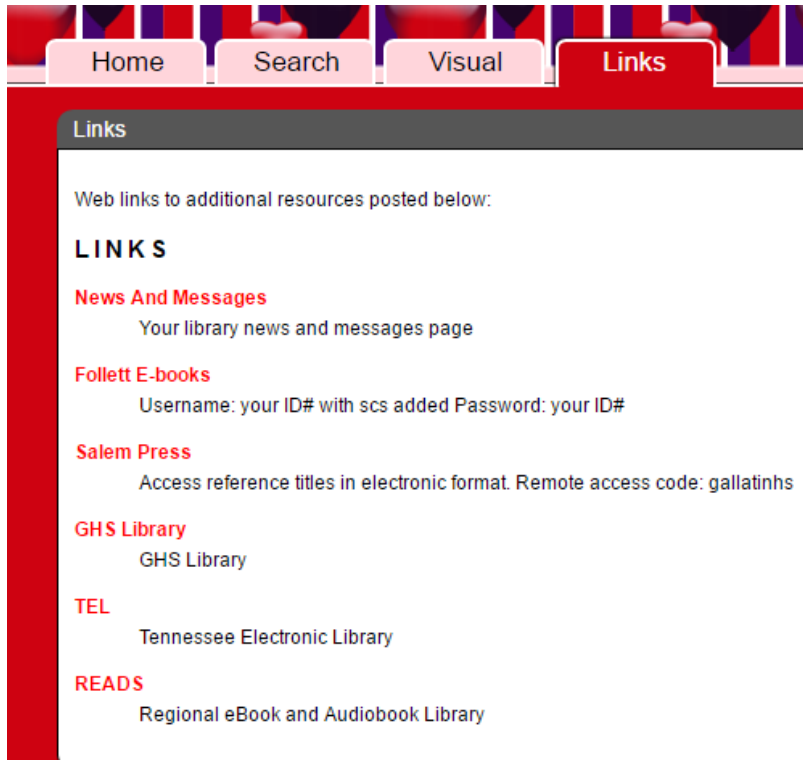
OR

Research Tips:

- If you have the option to register for an account or log in, do so. This will allow you many more options; such as, cite, save, print, email, etc articles of interest to you.
- Use advanced searches and filters to get the best results for you.



Atrium allows you to search GHS library books. You can even log into your *Bookbag* to reserve and renew books. How cool is that!

Student user: *firstname*<space>*lastname*

student PIN: your 6 digit birthdate (no slash/hyphen)

Teacher user: *firstandlastname* (no spaces)

teacher PIN: *firstinitiallastname* (no spaces)

Salem Press provides online reference titles in Literature, History and Science from award winning content to use for research. Your Remote Password: *gallatinhs*

R.E.A.D.S. is a way for you to read many books (fiction and nonfiction) free. You actually use your Gallatin Public library card to check out the books. You will be prompted to download an app to you can read the books offline. After two weeks, they will just disappear from your device. You should try it out sometime; it is pretty easy once you become familiar with it.



TEL (Tennessee Electronic Library) is a virtual library. IT is AWESOME! TEL provides access to over 400,000 electronic resources, including magazines, scholarly journals, podcasts, videos, e-books, test preparation materials, career tools, genealogy, teacher lesson plans, curricular resources, learn a new language, federal census records, TN primary resource materials, and much more. TEL works seamlessly with your personal Google account, Google Classroom and Microsoft accounts.



Student Resources is geared toward high school and college students. This should be the first place students should go if they are starting a research project. You will find it is very user friendly.

Sign in to your Google or Microsoft account so you can easily have access to the great benefits in *Tools*.

Follett/Destiny contains many non-fiction ebooks for your use. This is a great place to support your research projects and papers. Teachers: Lightbox offers interactive studies reaching across all subjects. See below.

Student user: ID# with "scs" added onto the end, PW: ID#

Teacher user: teacher email, PW: your *ST#*. This can be found in your iNow account or see the attached printout of the *ST* numbers for each teacher.

Lightbox are unit studies. There is an actual hard copy of the book you would check out and access to online material. You get a ton of supportive material, links, presentations, and much more to teach across all subjects to make your unit seamless. Lightbox has done the work for you. Currently, we have nine titles as of Feb. 2017. It is our hopes to add more.

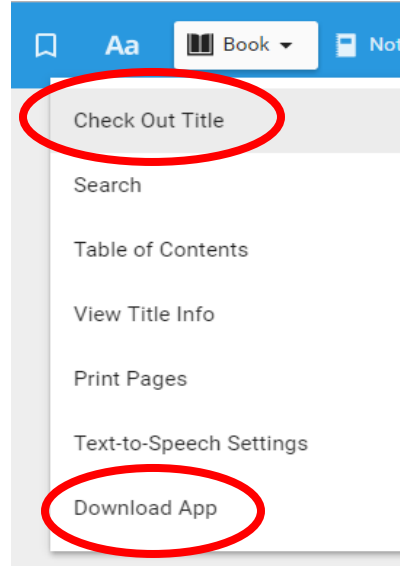
Ebooks show in your search. Easily cite, take notes, print excerpts and even have it read to you. See below for directions to read offline through the Destiny App.

Databases specifically related to your search.

Open Educational Resources are teaching and learning materials that you may freely use and reuse at no cost and without needing to ask permission. If for some reason you do not see the Open Ed Resources then make sure you are logged in; login directions are listed above.

Once you are in Follett/Destiny and you click on the **Books** tab, many options are available to you. The checkout period is for 7 days. The books will check themselves back in automatically, but if you are not using it then check it back in so other can have access. Notice you see **Download App**. This is so you can read the book offline and offers several format options with direct links and directions.



Want to know something else that is cool?

Use the **Google extension** Destiny Discover!

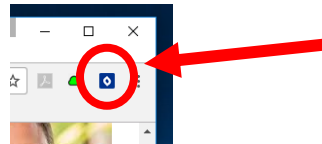
When you use the Chrome browser to research, at the top of your search results in a big, black ribbon you will see everything that your GHS Library has available in ebooks! Awesome, right?

How to install Destiny Discover as a Google Chrome extension:

1. From your Chrome browser, go to the Chrome Web Store and search for the Destiny Discover Extension.



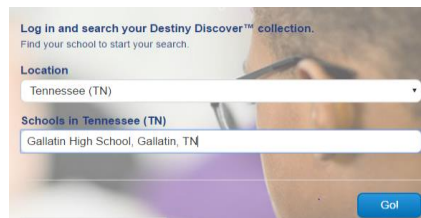
2. Click "Add to Chrome". A pop-up appears. Click "Add extension". A Destiny Discover icon has now been added to your Google Chrome toolbar.



3. Once you install Destiny Discover, you need to configure it to search the GHS Library only. If you do not see the direct link, *GoFollett.com* in the black ribbon then use <https://www.gofollett.com>

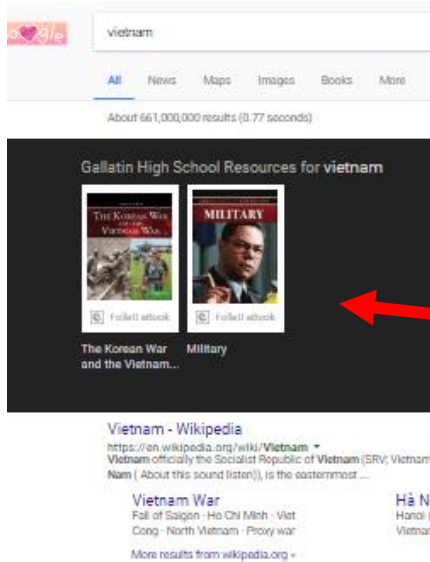
First Time Setup

Go to your school's Destiny Discover home page by selecting it from [GoFollett.com](https://www.gofollett.com) and your extension will auto-configure itself.

- Once the Google Chrome extension is configured for GHS Library, when you perform a Google search, you see Destiny Discover search results (ebooks that are currently in the GHS Library collection) in a black ribbon above the Google search results.



Example of what the GHS Library has in ebooks if you do a search on Vietnam. Notice the ebooks are in the black banner above the other Google search results. Like what you see? Then use the Follett/Destiny directions to check out the ebook!
