

# **Union High School Class of 1966 Alumni Scholarship**

## **The Program**

The Union High School Class of 1966 has established a scholarship program to assist high school students who show a desire to enter and/or continue a post-secondary program of study. The scholarship is awarded every two years to eligible students (preferable, but not limited to, minority students). Awards are granted without regard to creed, religion, gender, age, or physical disability.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants should use following criteria:

- Must be a graduate of an accredited high school
- Should have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA
- Demonstrate active involvement in school and/or community
- Exemplify exceptional character
- Have an acceptable ACT/SAT score

## **Awards**

A \$1000 award is presented to a recipient upon confirmation of proper enrollment in a post-secondary program.

## **Application**
